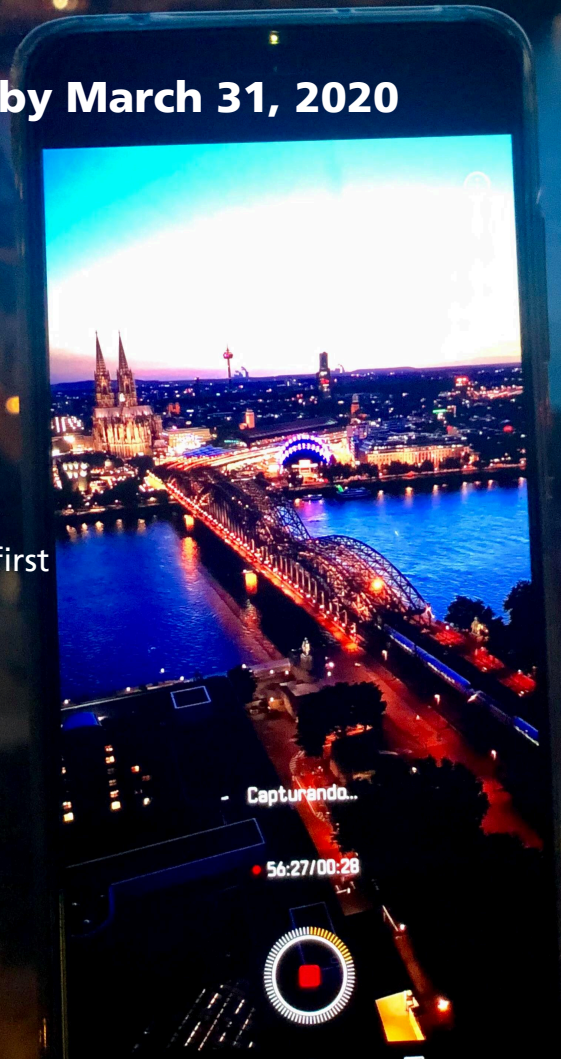


Cologne Summer School on Perspectives and Visions of Digital Societies
