Regulations for the Establishment of the Advisory Committee for “Engineering and Technology Education Accreditation”

Article I

In order to coordinate with the Department’s promotion of Engineering and Technology Education Accreditation and to understand the practical needs of the nation and society for talent so as to meet current trends and social demands, the “Engineering and Technology Education Accreditation” Advisory Committee (hereinafter referred to as “the Committee”) is hereby established.

Article II

The Committee shall consist of eleven advisory members, composed of five faculty representatives from the Department and six external members, including two representatives from industry, two from academia, and two alumni.

Article III – Selection and Term of Advisory Members

The Department Chair shall serve as an ex-officio member and the convener. Four faculty representatives shall be elected by the Department Affairs Meeting, making a total of five faculty members. External advisory representatives, including two industry representatives, two academic representatives, and two alumni representatives (six in total), shall be elected by the Department Affairs Meeting. The term of office is two years, and members are eligible for re-election.

Article IV – Primary Tasks of the Committee

1. To review, evaluate, and provide recommendations regarding the teaching effectiveness of the Department.
2. To assist in promoting the Department’s Engineering and Technology Education Accreditation work.

Article V

The Committee shall hold at least one meeting per academic year; extraordinary meetings may be convened when necessary.

Article VI

These regulations shall be implemented upon approval by the Department Affairs Meeting; the same shall apply to any future amendments.
